Polish Interpretation of this week's Gospel

Jezus pyta Ciebie dzisiaj: „Za kogo mnie uważasz?”. Jest to bardzo osobiste pytanie i musisz znaleźć na nie odpowiedź w swoim sercu. Nie ma znaczenia, co inni ludzie myślą lub mówią o Jezusie, nie ma także znaczenia, co Ty o nim wiesz. „Chrześcijaństwo nigdy nie bazuje na wiedzy o Jezusie, zawsze bazuje na naszym poznaniu Jezusa”. Prawdziwym pytaniem dzisiaj nie jest to, czy Jezus jest Zbawicielem świata, ale czy jest On Twoim Zbawicielem i czy wierzysz w to z całego serca.

Jesus is asking you today, 'Who do you say I am?' This is a very personal question and you need to find the answer to it in your heart. And it doesn't matter what other people think or say about Jesus, and it doesn't matter what you know about Him. 'Christianity never consists in knowing about Jesus, it always consists in knowing Jesus.' The real question today is not whether Jesus is the Saviour of the world, but whether Jesus is **your** Saviour and whether you believe it with all your heart.

ST DAMIEN MISSION GROUP

Hello everyone and I hope you are all keeping well in the strange and new normal times we are living in. Like everyone once covid 19 reached our shores and we went into lockdown our fundraising plans had to be shelved but we continued to receive news from our Brothers and Sisters working on the Missions and this is an update on one of these projects.

One of the first projects undertaken by us as a group over ten years ago was to help provide school books and other educational equipment for a school which was being built in Beira, Mozambique. To this day it remains very close to our hearts and when funding allows we send what we can afford. One of the reports recently received described how this area of Mozambique was battered by a hurricane resulting in most of the school being destroyed leaving the children with nowhere to go. On top of this there was a serious outbreak of covid 19 so work on rebuilding the school had to cease. Building has restarted and it is hoped that they can re-open in late August/ early September, pandemic permitting. Meanwhile the Brothers have the students planting tomatoes and various other vegetables to provide food and the surplus can be sold. It goes without saying that the building has eaten up most of the funding and there is little left for books etc.

While our fundraising plans have been put on hold and looks likely to be that way for the rest of the year we had a surplus from last year and our loyal supporters continue to leave in the coin boxes and regular donations. We are pleased to send, on your behalf, €1000 to Mozambique to help provide some of the equipment necessary to get them going again. This money is going directly to help the school and the children to get back to some kind of normality. This would not have been possible without your continued support and we thank you most sincerely for this. Our annual thanksgiving Mass for you our benefactors will take place on Mission Sunday in October. Meanwhile we will keep you all in our thoughts and prayers.
