Polish Interpretation of this week's Gospel

Imagine you are the wealthy landowner of today's gospel. Would you give tenants the same freedom or would you introduce more control? Would you be so patient with them, or would you immediately remove them from the vineyard when they beat the servants? Would you send your beloved son or daughter risking their lives? God the Father has given us, his children, a lot of freedom and is very generous in patience and grace. The time has come for us to learn to love others as He loves us.



This year, world Mission Sunday takes place on 18 October. Similar → to the Good Friday Collection for the Holy Land and Peter's Pence, World Mission Sunday is one of three yearly Universal Church collections. World Mission Sunday seeks to highlight, help believers understand, and respond to the call of mission for all baptized Christians.
