Sisters and brothers, with the current array of uncertainties associated with the Covid-19 pandemic, many questions about so many concerns have been posed but, as yet, have not bee met with a response. For us as a Catholic worshipping community one such question remains the Christmas Liturgical schedule. With the

present 'lockdown' to continue until 1 December, we are not in a position to know what are the possibilities open to us. Suffice to say, Christmas liturgy will be celebrated. However, as to its delivery platform, we do not know at the moment. Be assured that, as soon as we become aware, we will inform you. However, the possible lifting of restrictions on 1 December does not mean 'business as usual.'

November 23rd. The Feast of the Good Mother, Henriette Aymer de la Chevalerie, co-founder of the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. Born in 1767 into a noble family in a village near Poitiers (France). Henriette along with her mother spent some time in prison for sheltering Priests during the French Revolution. The time spent in prison would change her outlook on life. What she experienced and witnessed changed her vision of reality. Pierre Coudrin (the Good Father) directs her to the Association of the Sacred Heart. The Good Mother begins to feel a deep spiritual experience. She told Pierre "when you organized the adoration and assigned me an hour without suspecting it, you fixed my destiny". On 20th. October 1800 The Good Mother and four companions took their first vows. On Christmas Eve of that year the Founders solemnly make definitive vows. This date marks the birth of our Congregation. At the time of her death in 1834 she had founded 17 communities and accepted 900 Sisters for profession in the Congregation.
