### Polish Reflection on this week's Gospel

During the last supper, Lord Jesus broke the bread and said 'this is my body', then He gave the wine to his disciples and told them it is his blood. Is the Eucharist just a symbol for you? The Eucharist is not only a meeting of the faithful during which we remember Jesus, but it is a sacrament in which we receive His Body and Blood. We nourish on God who has unlimited power to transform our hearts and strengthen our souls. We take the body of God who is The healer and The healing. Let us not forget how great a gift this is for us.
