

From the Archbishop, Dermot Farrell: In a recent letter to all priests, Archbishop Farrell outlined the dire financial situation in which the archdiocese currently finds itself. The fact is that the effects of the Covid-19 pandemic with its accompanying restrictions on public worship has further negatively impacted what had already been a difficult financial situation with the continuous decline in income throughout the entirety of the archdiocese theretofore. Consequently, in an effort to address this financial crisis, with particular reference to pastoral services and priests' income, Archbishop Farrell has introduced a **Summer Dues** collection which will take place at Masses of the weekend of **Sunday, 20 June**. Copies of the more detailed letter from the Archbishop pertaining to this situation are available on the table at the back of the church. I write this note to you conscious of your generosity to our local parish community here at Sruleen. *It seems that our collections during the Covid-19 period have holding up better than many, even larger parishes!!
