



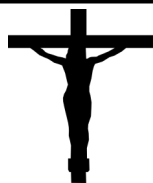

Polish Reflection on this week's Gospel

God's will is to come into your life with Love and Power. And it doesn't matter what you look like, what you do right now or what happened in your past. He wants to come into your life to heal your soul. What do you need to do to make it happen? You need to awaken a desire in your heart. The deaf man in today's Gospel could not pray to God with his mouth, he could not call Jesus and beg Him for help. But the desire and longing for God in his heart were enough for Jesus to hear him. Do not be afraid, open your heart, your God is coming to save you.
