Polish Reflection on this week's Gospel

In today's gospel, people ask John the Baptist, "what must we do?" Maybe it is worth asking yourself this question from time to time? John, in his response, encourages them to be loving and honest, but St. Paul goes a step further in his letter: "Be happy in the Lord". God is greater than a virus, greater than any disease or our daily problems. We believe God has everything under control and we don't need to worry about anything. Joy and true happiness distinguish us believers from unbelievers. Jesus Christ died on the cross for us so that we would experience it. Let us be happy and rejoice because we are in His hands!
