Polish Reflection on this week's Gospel

When we read the gospel of the prodigal son, we can usually identify with one of the sons. For, just like them, we can define ourselves as lost sheep in need of conversion. However, we should not forget that we are ambassadors of the Lord Jesus on earth, and we should also show the heart of our Father in heaven with our lives. Think about the father in this parable. Would you be able to forgive your child for treating you like this? Wouldn't you think that they made a choice and should deal with the consequences on their own? But God's heart is different. Ask the Holy Spirit today to show you the people you need to forgive, pray for them and show them what God's love for a man really looks like. It is a perfect time to do this.



27th March. Feast day of Pierre Coudrin SS.CC.

The birth of the Congregation is rooted in the *French Revolution*.
 In March 1792, a Frenchman named Pierre Coudrin was secretly
 ordained to the priesthood. The following May, in the midst of a
 nation in turmoil turning against Catholic religious leaders, Father Coudrin went
 into hiding. During his time in hiding, Fr Coudrin had a vision in which he saw a
 band of missionaries—men and women—dedicated to spreading the Gospel
 everywhere. Fr Coudrin took the decision to come out of hiding and exercise
 his priestly ministry, because of the turmoil that existed in the area he was
 forced to do this *under cover*. Fr Coudrin was waiting for the right moment to
 found the Order. On Christmas Eve in 1800, knowing they could face the guillo-
 tine for their actions, Father Coudrin along with his co-founder Henriette Aymer
 de Chevalerie officially established the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of
 Jesus and Mary and of Perpetual Adoration with a mission to spread the mes-
 sage of God's unconditional love as manifested through the Hearts of Jesus and
 Mary and finding God's mercy through the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.
