A Polish Reflection on this week's Gospel

Everyone can see how the world today is divided. Disagreements between states, disagreements in our families are ubiquitous. Even the disciples of Jesus are divided. Before his death, the Lord Jesus prayed for his disciples and future generations that they would be one in Him. Our inspirational homilies will not help people to believe in Jesus if our churches continue to be divided.

In the first reading, we see Stephen forgiving those who stone him and being fully united with God. Only such an attitude will give us peace in our hearts and make us not afraid of anything, even death.
