Why should we be humble in our prayers? Or in the way we speak or behave towards others? Without humility, we do not meet with others, we do not meet God, we do not listen. A person who lacks humility simply adores themselves and their feelings in every situation. Without humility, we meet only with ourselves, and this is contrary to what Jesus teaches us and what it means to love other people.
