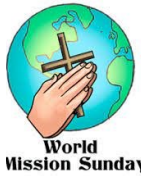

No doubt matters raised and discussed will include concerns, initiatives and desires raised by local parish gatherings, and Diocesan Synods that have already taken place in different parts of the world. The Dublin Archdiocesan Synod is in the process of preparation. Let us pray for our entire church community as it prepares for and approaches another pivotal moment in history and tradition.

O God of peace, you have established Jerusalem as the Lord's House and a place of peace, and you have called on all who live there to love you and prosper. Instill in her inhabitants - Jews, Christians and Muslims - a hunger for justice and dignity and a resolve to end the distrust that culminates in violence. In this endeavour, make every one of us agents of your peace, O God. Forgive us our indifference and stamp out the prejudices that lead to hatred. Fill us with the reconciling spirit of your presence. So may we join people of good will - in the Middle East and throughout the world - who raise before Jerusalem's gates their insistent Shalom and Salaam: ***"Peace be within your walls. . . .Peace be within you."***
