ON THE LIGHTER SIDE!

This week's 'Lighter Side,' is comprised of a funny quote and story from the life of St Teresa of Avila (1515 - 1582) who had a great sense of humour and whose feast day is on this Wednesday 15th Oct. She was nicknamed "Big Tess" because of her big personality and tremendous contribution to the Church, and to distinguish her from the 'Little Flower' (St Thérèse of Lisieux). One of her most well-known sayings, (that shows the importance of not taking oneself too seriously) is: "From silly devotions and sour-faced saints, good Lord deliver us!" Her sense of humour was especially evident in her relationship with God. A favourite story that St Teresa loved to tell, concerned a time when she was travelling in terrible weather. As she was riding



to her destination, she fell into the mud. The typical reaction, it seems, would either be one of frustration or holy acceptance. Teresa **found the middle ground** (excuse the pun!) - a tongue-in-cheek prayer: "Lord," she said, "*If this is how you treat your friends..it's no wonder you have so few of them!*" St Teresa of Avila, comedian and saint, pray for us!
