


PLEASE SWITCH OFF ALL MOBILE PHONES OR PLACE THEM ON SILENT BEFORE MASS BEGINS



As has been customary, there will be *STATIONS OF THE CROSS*, after Mass every Friday during Lent, which each week will be led by a different parish group. Also, a new initiative "*BRINGING JESUS HOME*," discussed at the last meeting of the combined Clondalkin parishes, is being offered during Lent. Parishioners will be invited to host a **short period of Adoration** in their home, where they invite friends and neighbours to attend. This will involve **collecting the monstrance from the Church**, before the planned time of Adoration, and returning the monstrance to the Church afterwards. A *simple prayer schedule sheet*, will also be provided. Please leave your name, address and phone number in the Sacristy, if you would like to host such a time of Adoration in your home during Lent.

Please keep our two 2nd Year Classes, their families & their teachers in you prayers, as they prepare for their *FIRST CONFESSION* this Wednesday evening.



There will be silent *ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT*, during the Sundays of Lent in the Village Church, Clondalkin, from 3.30pm to 5.15pm. All welcome.



Looking for a more *Contemplative approach* to the Mass? The 9.15am Mass on Friday Mornings, provides increased times of reflection and silence during the liturgy. Some *LECTIO DIVINA* (Sacred Reading/Reflection) on part of that day's scriptures, replaces the Homily, with plenty of time for personal assimilation of God's Word.
