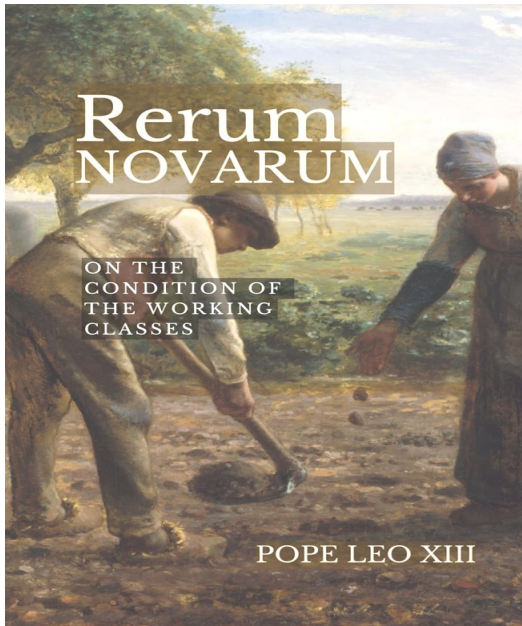

What is an **Encyclical**? It is an official pastoral letter written by the Pope providing a teaching instruction on matters or morals, doctrine and contemporary social issues—on **25th May 2026, Pope Leo XIV**—on the **135th Anniversary of the publication of *RERUM NOVARUM [OF NEW THINGS]*** by his namesake, **Pope Leo XIII**, regarding industrialization conditions of working-class people, and setting the groundwork for modern Catholic Social Teaching - published the Encyclical, ***MAGNIFICA HUMANITATIS [MAGNIFICENT HUMANITY]***. It is the first Encyclical of Pope Leo XIV, focused on protecting human dignity in the age of

artificial intelligence [AI]. The document explores how AI is reshaping work, communications, politics, and warfare, while warning against technologies that reduce international regulation of emerging technologies. Pope Leo XIV emphasizes that innovation must always serve humanity, promoting compassion, truth, solidarity, and the common good rather than domination, inequality, or technological control over human life.
